

Things To Consider when Building a Character Home

- 🏠 Consider what time period you want your character home to reflect?
 - Villa: 1900's - 1920's = curves & jewellery, lots of prettiness
 - Bungalow: 1940's - 1950's = clean lines, square edges
- 🏠 Do you want the character limited to the exterior of your home or do you envisage it right the way through the entire home?
- 🏠 Budget. Adding character to a home can come at expense. However this is extra cost is reflected in resale value and the valuation of your home.
- 🏠 Allow room in the budget for landscaping! A formal garden will really complete your character home.
- 🏠 What traditional pieces do you want to include in your home?
 - For example: a special front door, door knocker, ceiling roses, art collection, light fittings etc.
